REACH STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

Raw Materials

Recovered Paper

According to the European Waste Directive, recovered paper is currently legally considered as waste and as such does not need to be registered under REACH.

Recycled pulp

Registration is not required for any type of pulp including recycled pulp and de-inked market pulp. These are natural substances, not chemically modified and not classified as dangerous.

Chemicals

For chemicals, Papermill Doetinchem is a down stream user and therefore registration is not required.

All necessary actions, so far, have been taken:

- The intended use has been communicated to our suppliers.
- All substances are pre-registered and are intended to be registered by our suppliers.
- Used chemicals do not contain any substance mentioned on the SVHC candidate list of ECHA.

Papermill Doetinchem will monitor the progress of REACH and accept its responsibilities.

Paper

The raw material, recovered paper, is converted in the mill to pulp en de-inked pulp. These are natural substances, not chemically modified and not classified as dangerous. Papermill Doetinchem does not add any substance mentioned on the SVHC candidate list of ECHA and therefore the paper does not need to be registered.
