as well as of the;


Foodstuffs, Consumer Goods and Animal Feed Code (Foodstuffs and Animal Feed Code – LFGB) in the version of the notification of 26 April 2006, last amendment of 26 February 2008, state of 1 March 2008, §§ 30 and 31,

and may thus be used safely for the printing of labels and food packaging, provided that it is ensured by an appropriate printing technique that the printings do not migrate from the printing substrates onto the foodstuffs.

The packagings and labels manufactured with the Markem-Imaje 3810 Thermal Transfer ribbon may safely come into direct contact with dry, moist and fatty foodstuffs as far as the mentioned inks are concerned.
